Jeanneau NC11



Winner of the 2011 European Power Boat of the Year award, the Jeanneau NC11 is, according to its designers, a totally new take on life on the water.

Designed by Garroni and Premorel Concept, Jeanneau says the contemporary elegance of the NC11 is complemented by light and space, with a seamless integration of the cockpit station and the stylish living area. The layout features two cabins, a bathroom and a saloon, while Jeanneau says the stern drive transmission and twin Z-drive engines offer quiet, efficient power.

With a panoramic view from the helm, Jeanneau says its NC11 brings boaters closer to the elements, with plenty of natural light and ventilation. Three sliding glass panel doors leading to the aft deck retract in one smooth motion, as does the sunroof, while the bench seating can be repositioned



forward or back as needed. The owner's cabin offers indulgent ocean views and a walk-in wardrobe, while the aft cabin can be configured with either double or twin berths.

Bow access is simple and safe, with wide sidedecks that are easily accessible. The galley is open to the cockpit but can be hidden away to become an integral part of the saloon furniture, while a diesel heater provides warmth on cooler days.
